

Spring Forest HOA Pool Rules

The swimming pool is provided for the comfort and pleasure of Spring Forest residents and their invited guests only. Invited guests must be always accompanied by a resident while at the pool and residents must carry a wristband when at the pool. Users found to be using the pool without being accompanied by a resident can be arrested for trespassing. Residents found to have in any way provided the pool key or access to non-residents will be subject to fines up to \$200.00 which will be assessed to their accounts and payable to the Association.

Pool wristbands and Pond/Lake passes are required to be always carried while at the Pond/Lake.

Fishing allowed, catch and release only. NO SWIMMING OR BOATING.

Anyone using the pool must comply with the following rules:

SPRING FOREST POOL RULES & REGULATIONS

1. NO LIFEGUARD IS PROVIDED: All swimming will be at your own risk
2. Alcohol is permitted. Food and beverages are only permitted on the pool deck in non-breakable containers.
3. No diving is allowed.
4. The pool is for use by Spring Forest residents. A unit resident must accompany all guests. A maximum of four (4) guests are permitted per unit at any one time. Wrist bands must be used, and everyone must sign in.
5. The pool is open from dawn to dusk daily. The Pitt County Health Department requires that the pool be closed at dusk. Violators will be arrested and prosecuted for trespassing.
6. Parties are not allowed
7. Suitable swimming attire should be worn, and showers must be taken before entering the pool.
8. Children under the age of 16 may use the pool only if accompanied by a responsible adult.
9. No one is allowed in the pool with open sores, or without waterproof bandages.
10. Tossing games (Ball, frisbee, etc.), running, roller skating, rollerblading, skateboarding, or bicycle riding are strictly prohibited on the pool deck.
11. The use of radios, tape recorders and musical instruments is only permitted at low to moderate levels, not disturbing to other residents.
12. No animals are permitted in the pool or pool area.
13. Rafts or any other inflatable objects are prohibited in the pool. This does not include children's water wings which are allowed.
14. Children who are not potty trained must wear water-tight diapers (Little swimmers)
15. Any person trespassing inside the pool area after hours or any non-residents in the pool without a Spring Forest resident with them will be subject to arrest or prosecution.

Anyone who fails to comply with the Pool Rules or who provides non-residents access to the pool will, in addition to the fines established, have all pool privileges revoked for a period to be determined by the Board of Directors based on the severity of the violation.
