Treetops General HOA Pool
Changes for 2019

Registration

Only unit residents may register for pool entry cards. This means that non-resident owners may not register and receive pool entry cards on behalf of their tenants.

Non-resident owners may register for cards for their personal use.

Pool Entry Cards or Pool Key Fob Entry

A new gate locking system will be in place for the 2019 Pool Season in addition to security camera monitoring/surveillance.

Current Secura Key entry cards will be exchanged for new entry cards during registration which will work with the new locking system.

****You MUST bring your current pool card in order to exchange it for a new pool card during registration. There will be no charge for card exchange. ****

Be aware: The newly installed security camera system will send a phone alert to designated persons in the event movement is detected inside the pool fenced area before opening time, (9:00 am), and after closing time, (8:00 pm). Therefore, you must adhere to pool opening and closing times or risk

- 1) having your pool card revoked for a two week period and**
- 2) being required to pay a \$10.00 reactivation fee in order to regain pool privileges.**

Persons with revoked pool cards may not be guests of other pool card holders.

Key Fob Entry

To obtain a **key fob** for entry purposes instead of using an entry card you must

- 1) place your order for a key fob during pool registration
- 2) provide a **check** in the amount of \$10.00 payable to "Treetops General HOA".
Cash, debit or credit cards will not be accepted.

Orders for pool entry key fobs will be placed following the close of the May 11, 2019 pool registration date. Persons who order key fobs will be contacted to arrange a time to exchange new entry cards for key fobs.
